### Materials required or supplied with your kit.

Colour	Tiles		Materials	
	size (cm)	no.		
Navy	10 x10	12	Tile Glue	4 kg
Sky	10 x10	8	Tile grout	5 kg
Med Blue	10 x10	16	Sealant	1 ltr
Purple	10 x10	18	Plywood Base 15mm min. thickness, 90cm diam.	
Lime	10 x10	22	4 x 16mm screws & wire	

### Tools

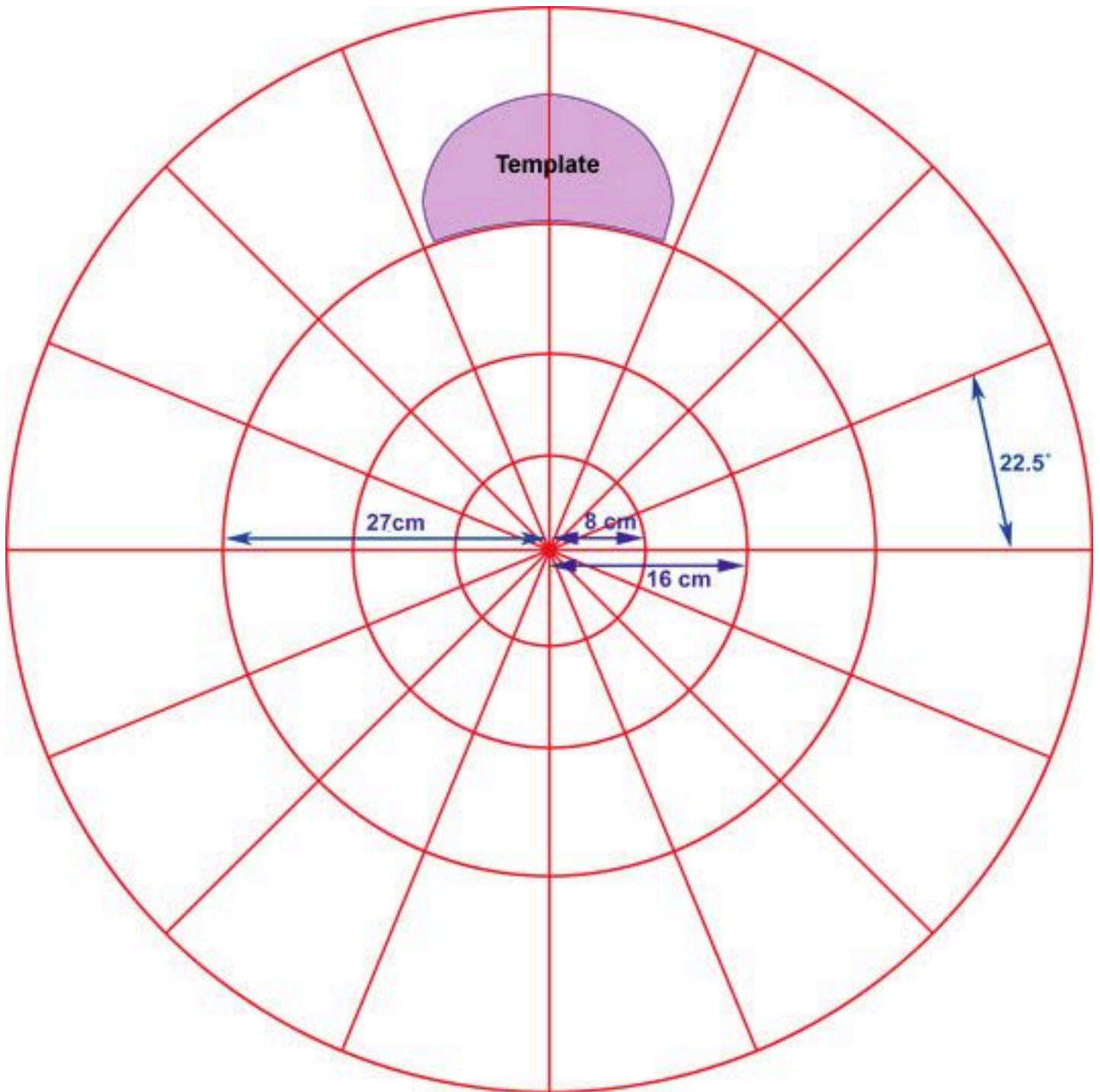
#### Required

Curved edge tile nippers  
Grouting tool (or use something from around the house)

#### Desirable

Both curved & straight edged tile nippers  
Boat Grouter  
Sliding tile cutter

## Guidelines required for "70's Flower" mosaic design.

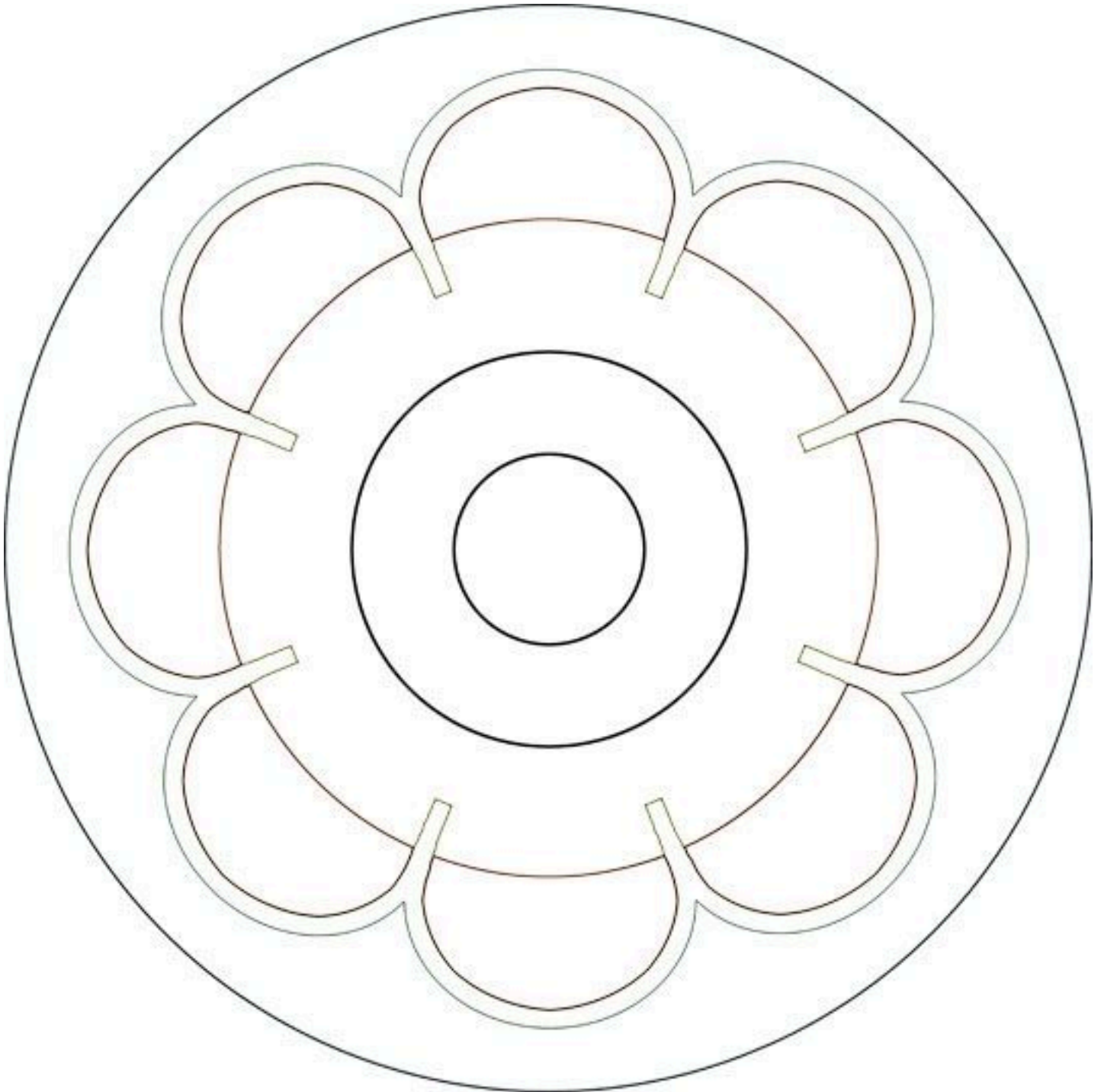


1. Draw lines as shown with a protractor & a compass
2. Carefully cut your templates out (cardboard page) with scissors or a stanley knife. Cut *outside* the lines edging the template.
3. Line up the petal template on the guideline as shown, tracing around it on every second section. Your mosaic lines will go outside this drawn section. Note also that the lines extend a little further inward than your template does.

## Alternative methods of transferring the design

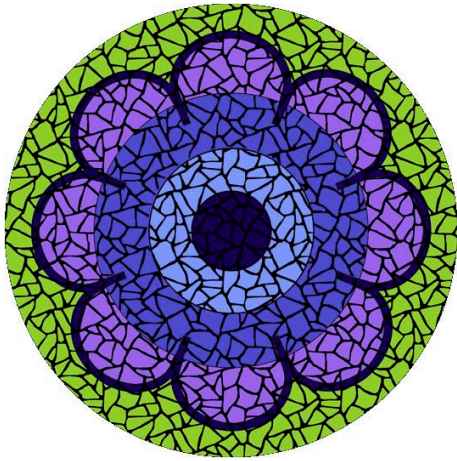
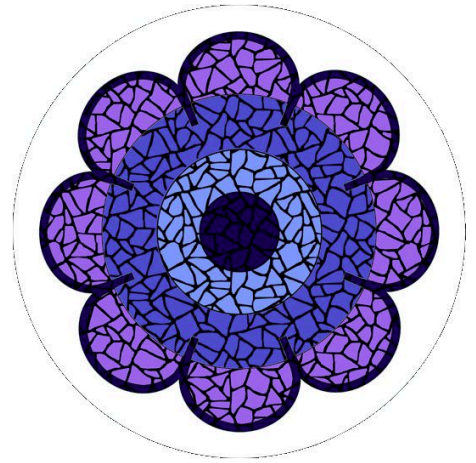
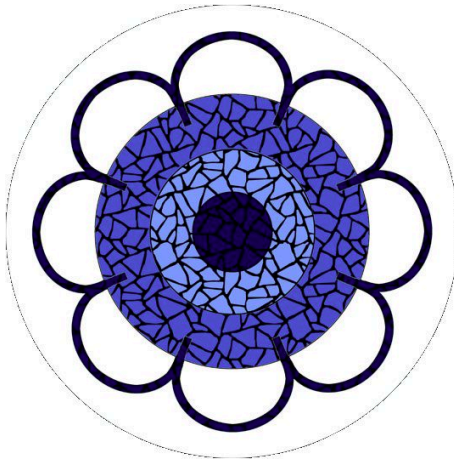
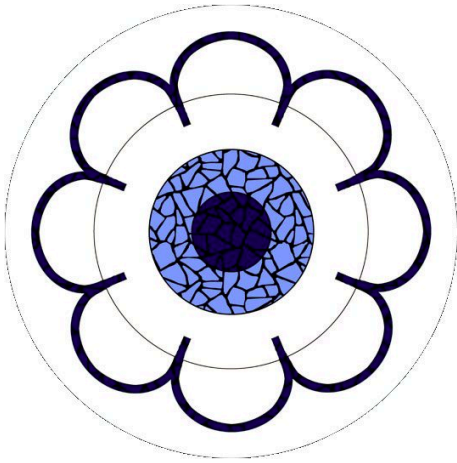
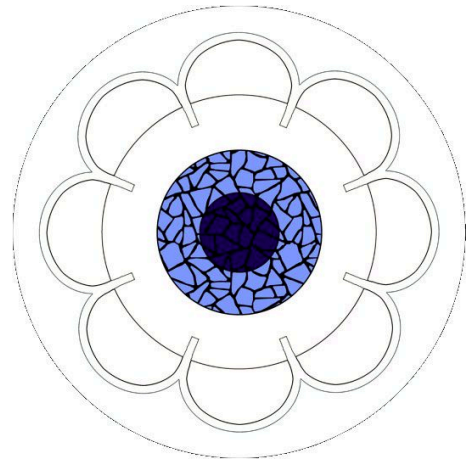
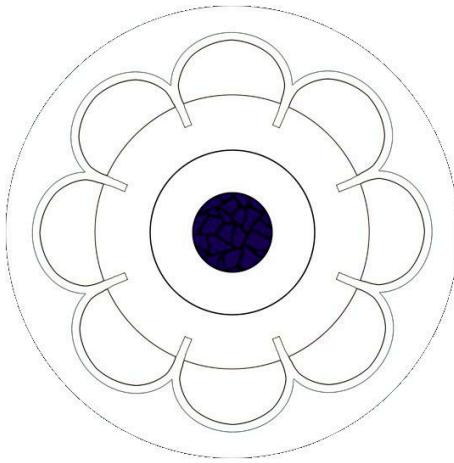
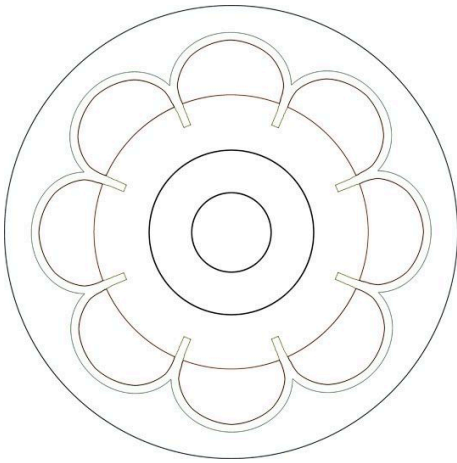
The drawing below could be taken to a photocopy or print shop and enlarged to your desired size. You can then use carbon paper to trace the design directly onto your backing board.
