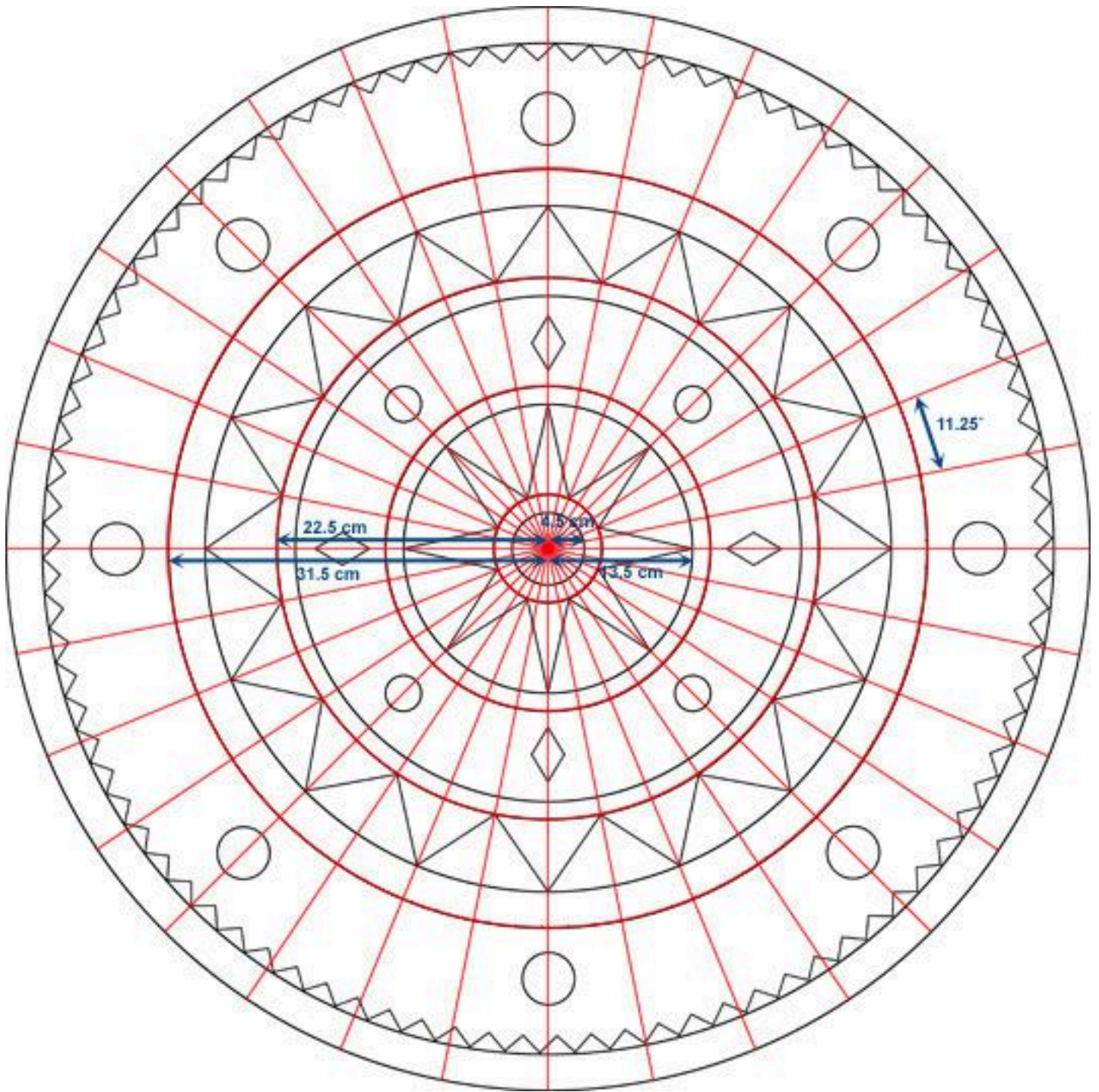
### Materials required

Tiles			Materials	
Colour	size (cm)	no.		
Red	10 x10	3	Tile Glue	4 kg
Orange	10 x10	10	Tile grout	5 kg
Chocolate	10 x10	19	Sealant	1 litre
Toffee	10 x10	10	Plywood Base 15mm min. thickness, 40cm diam.	
Caramel	10 x10	30	2 x 16mm screws & wire	

### Tools

Required	Desirable
Curved edge tile nippers	Both curved & straight edged tile nippers
Grouting tool (or use something from around the house)	Boat Grouter

## Guidelines required for "Aztec Sun" mosaic design.

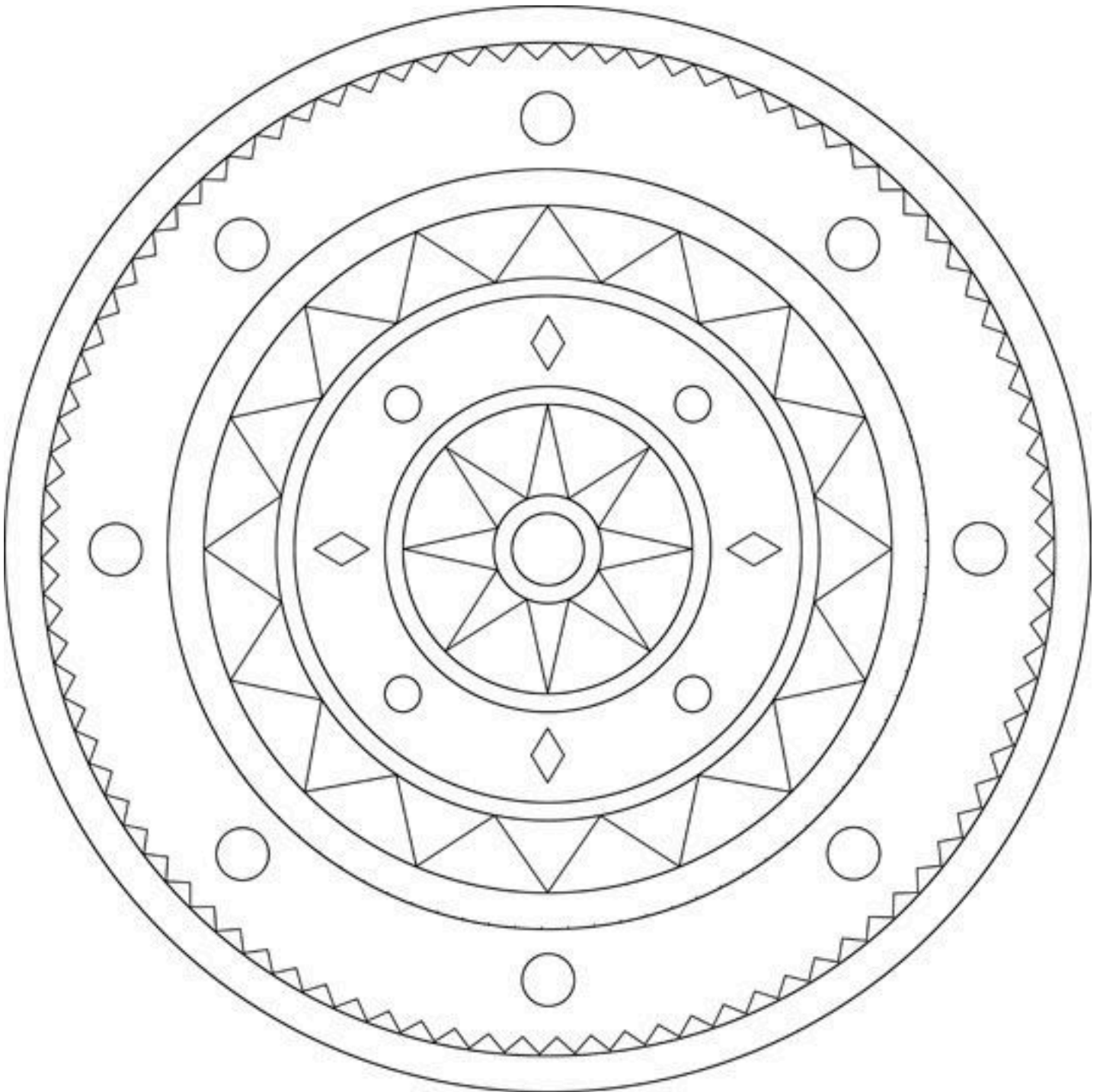


1. Draw red lines as shown with a ruler, protractor & compass.
2. Carefully transfer the drawing onto the board using the lines as a guide. Note where the black intersects the red
3. Trace over with a felt pen if you like.

## Alternative methods of transferring the design

The drawing below could be taken to a photocopy or print shop and enlarged to your desired size. You can then use carbon paper to trace the design directly onto your backing board.

You could also draw a grid on the design and a corresponding grid onto your backing board and draw the lines in yourself
