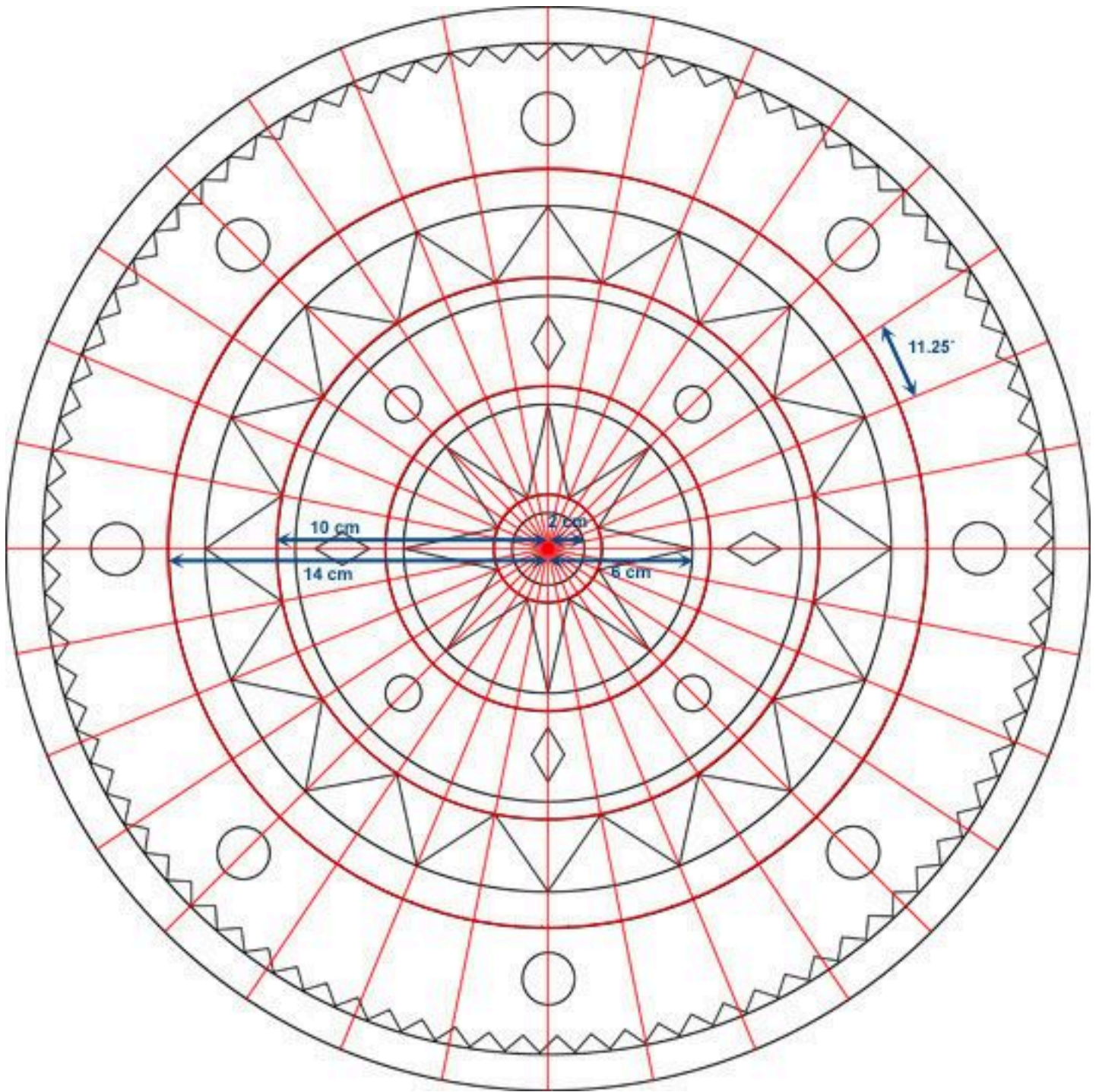
Materials required

| Colour | Tiles | | Materials | |
|--------|-----------|-----|--|-------|
| | size (cm) | no. | | |
| Red | 10 x10 | 1 | Tile Glue | 1 kg |
| Grape | 10 x10 | 4 | Tile grout | 1 kg |
| Purple | 10 x10 | 6 | Sealant | 250ml |
| Lilac | 10 x10 | 2 | Plywood Base 15mm min. thickness, 40cm diam. | |
| Navy | 10 x10 | 2 | 2 x 16mm screws & wire | |

Tools

| Required | Desirable |
|--|---|
| Curved edge tile nippers | Both curved & straight edged tile nippers |
| Grouting tool (or use something from around the house) | Boat Grouter |

Guidelines required for "Aztec Sun" mosaic design.

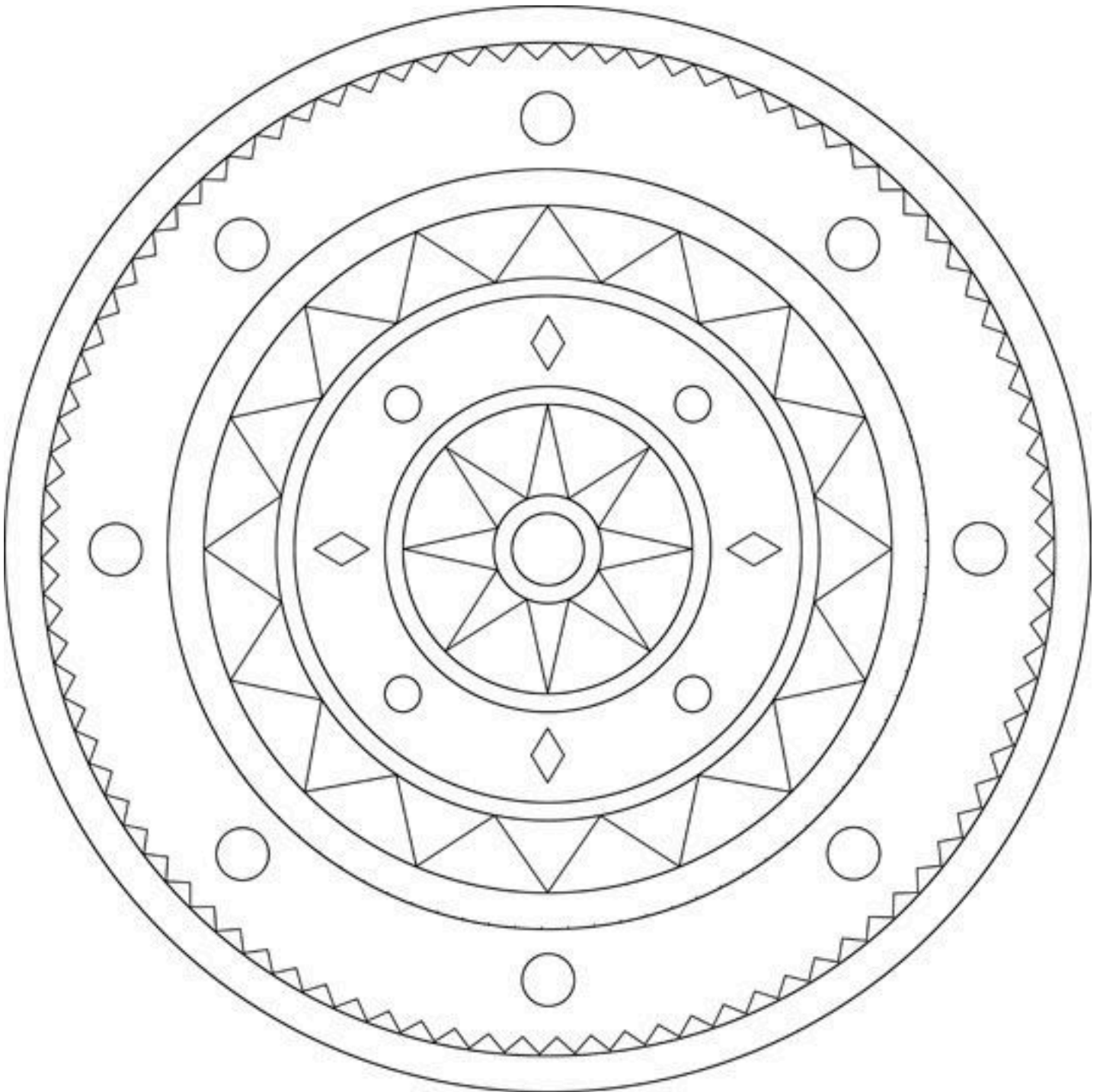


1. Draw red lines as shown with a ruler, protractor & compass.
2. Carefully transfer the drawing onto the board using the lines as a guide. Note where the black intersects the red
3. Trace over with a felt pen if you like.

Alternative methods of transferring the design

The drawing below could be taken to a photocopy or print shop and enlarged to your desired size. You can then use carbon paper to trace the design directly onto your backing board.

You could also draw a grid on the design and a corresponding grid onto your backing board and draw the lines in yourself



Suggested laying order
