


"Mindseye Chakra"

mosaic design for a 90cm mural or tabletop

Materials required or supplied with your kit.

Guidelines required for "Chakra" mosaic design.




- 1. Draw lines as shown with a protractor & a compass
- **2.** Carefully cut your templates out (cardboard page)with scissors or a stanley knife. Cut *outside* the lines edging the template.
- **3.** Line up the petal template on the guideline as shown, tracing around it on every second section. Your mosaic lines will go outside this drawn section.
- 4. Then line the template up on the odd lines, and draw in your partly obscured petals.
- 5. Draw in the sun's rays by hand one for each line.


Alternative methods of transferring the design

The drawing below could be taken to a photocopy or print shop and enlarged to your desired size. You can then use carbon paper to trace the design directly onto your backing board.

You could also draw a grid on the design and a corresponding grid onto your backing board and draw the lines in yourself
