
Materials required

Tiles			Materials	
Colour	size (cm)	no.	Tile Glue	2 kg
Black	10 x10	16	Tile grout	2 kg
Red	10 x10	5	Sealant	500ml
Bronzegold	10 x10	12	Plywood Base 15mm min. thickness, 60cm diam.	
			2 x 16mm screws & wire	2

Tools

Required	Desirable	
Curved edge tile nippers	Both curved & straight edged tile nippers	
Grouting tool (or use something from around the house)	Boat Grouter	

Guidelines required for "Indian Flowers" mosaic design.



- 1. Draw red lines as shown with a ruler.
- 2. Carefully transfer the drawing onto the board using the lines as a guide. Note where the black intersects the red
- 3. Trace over with a felt pen if you like.

Alternative methods of transferring the design

The drawing below could be taken to a photocopy or print shop and enlarged to your desired size. You can then use carbon paper to trace the design directly onto your backing board.

You could also draw a grid on the design and a corresponding grid onto your backing board and draw the lines in yourself
